

'HGLGA General Meeting Minutes 03/05/2025

The General Meeting was called to order by President Karen Sullivan at 1:10 p.m.

- 1. Minutes** - Last month's General Meeting minutes were approved by Barb Callaghan and seconded by Carol Davies.
- 2. Treasurer's Report** - Ann Bazinet reported we have approx. \$4000 in the Treasury after the Solheim expenses.
- 3. Membership** - Sharon Pedersen said we currently have 112 members. Two new members were introduced, Diane Nehring, a resident of HG, and Michelle Thomson, a non-resident member.
- 4. East West Tournament** - This tournament will be on April 9. The East Captain is Dale Prescott and the West Captain is Kim Basile. That evening will be the Awards Dinner.
- 5. HGLGA Board Search Committee** - Bernadette Schirra, along with Linda Birecree and Pam Bedore, were the committee that found volunteers to form the slate of officers for next season. The nominees are Kim Mueller for VP, Mary Donoghue for Secretary, Pam Bedore and Sharon Pedersen for Tournaments, and Andy Edmunds for Membership.
- 6. Hole in One** - Bernadette Schirra reported that Jackie Stratton had a hole in one on #11.
- 7. Eagles** - Jen Ronningen reported that Judy Tennant had an Eagle on #1 and Jen Ronningen had Eagles on #12 and #18.
- 8. Ringer Board** - Lind Birecree announced the ringer board scorecard winners. The 5 tee winner was Jackie Stratton with 68, the 5 / 6 winner was Robinanne Wale with 73 (Cheryl Braunscheidel was 72

but was not present to win), and the 6 tee winner was Marie Laidler with 75.

9. Rules - Trish Perry discussed that a lost ball is penalized by stroke and distance. Also, in Match play, once players leave a hole you can not change a score, so players must agree on who won the hole at the end of each hole.

10. Maximum Handicap Strokes - Karen discussed a decision made by the Board that the maximum handicap strokes given in the 18 Hole League is 36.

11. Coming Events - April 6, Sunday, is the Shoot Out at 3:30. April 9, Wednesday, is the Awards Banquet and it is a dinner meeting at 5:00.
